

**NOISE CONTROL
RULES and REGULATIONS of
ARROWHEAD AT VAIL ASSOCIATION**
Adopted March 27, 2007

WHEREAS, Arrowhead at Vail Association ("Association") is responsible for adopting and enforcing rules and regulations relating to the use and occupancy of properties within Arrowhead at Vail pursuant to the Second Amended and Restated Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, Restrictions and Easements for Arrowhead at Vail; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATED TO NOISE CONTROL ARE HEREBY ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ARROWHEAD AT VAIL ASSOCIATION:

I. NOISE PROHIBITED AFTER 11:00 P.M. AND BEFORE 7:00 A.M.

The making, creating or allowing of an excessive or an unusually loud noise or amplified sound at any outside location within Arrowhead at Vail between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. heard and measured in a manner hereinafter set forth is hereby prohibited.

II. DEFINITION AND DETERMINATION OF EXCESSIVELY OR UNUSUALLY LOUD NOISE

A. An excessive or unusually loud noise is any sound emanating from a property within Arrowhead at Vail that can be heard from inside a residence on another property within Arrowhead at Vail when all windows and outside doors at that property are closed.

B. An Arrowhead at Vail Public Safety officer will determine whether a noise is excessive or unusually loud if the Public Safety officer can hear the noise from inside the property complaining of the noise when all windows and outside doors at that property are closed.

III. EXCLUSIONS

This regulation shall not be effective, and no provision hereof shall be enforced, between the hours of 11:00 P.M. on July 4 and 7:00 A.M. on July 5 of any year, or between the hours of 11:00 P.M. on December 31 of any year and 7:00 A.M. on January 1 of the following year.


IV. EFFECTIVE DATE
